DBC Race Regulations (Revised January 2018):

Sport Mixed, University Mixed, Junior Mixed Divisions: Must be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 paddlers of each gender

Sport Crews

- Each member of a Sport Division Crew (Sport Mixed, Sport Women, Sport Open) must be a registered member with Dragon Boat Canada
- TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SPORT DIVISION AT PICKERING ALL ATHLETES MUST BE REGISTERED INTO THE DBC SYSTEM BY MAY 23

- DBC ID must be shown at marshalling before each race
- Roster checkers will be at marshalling for each sport race
- PFDs are optional for Sport Races ONLY

- Free festival shuttle buses will be operating all day both days
- Athletes, coaches, volunteers and supporters MUST park at the Pickering Go Station Auxiliary Parking Lot on the West Side of Sandy Beach Rd (North of Bayly). This lot is located 1-block east of the Pickering GO station
- Detailed parking instructions will be sent to each team captain in addition to this bulletin to ensure best possible communication of the parking plan
